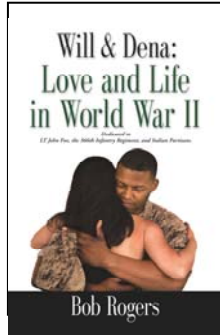

### Synopsis:
